3D ANIMATION: In this event, judges evaluate student (teams of 2 or 3) oral presentations in which animation is used to create a standalone video product. This event consists of a 3D animated video that shall be no more than three (3) minutes in length. The overview of the design and development efforts will be presented to a panel of judges. Due to participation levels, the judges for this event are typically combined with another similar event.
