Regional conferences will occur virtually this year. This means that there will be no in-person events; all objective tests will be taken online at school or home and all performance events will be judged through a video submission or live online judging. Summary of key dates for regional conferences

Online testing window

For events that have an online test, all online testing will be completed in each chapter's home school or at the student's home beginning on November 30, 2020. The closing date for online testing is 5 p.m. on December 23.

New for 2020-21: For objective tests that are team events, each student on the team will take the same test separately and the scores from all team members will be averaged to determine the final objective test score for the team. Previously students on a team would take one collaborative test, however with the circumstances of most schools not being in-person at this time, taking collaborative tests will likely not be possible. To be consistent across all chapters, everyone will follow the procedure of taking separate tests for team events and scores will be averaged to determine the team's final objective test score.

Registration process--How to register for competitive events at regional conferences

Registration for all regional conference competitive events must be completed using the Blue Panda online registration system. You will receive an e-mail directly from the Blue Panda system with a link to the system to register for regionals

The Blue Panda system is tied directly to National FBLA's dues database. If National FBLA has not received dues for your students, you will NOT be able to register your student(s) for competitive events at the regional conference.

Registration Fee

The state chapter will assess a \$5 registration fee for each student competing in a competitive event at the regional level. Once you finalize your registration, a statement will be generated with payment instructions. All money for the conference is due by December 4, 2020. Please make arrangements with your school's financial secretary now to ensure you will not have a problem getting your chapter's check issued prior to December 4, 2020.

The state chapter is offering a credit card payment option for chapters that are not able to get a check issued by December 4, 2020. This option is for chapter payments only (individual payments from students cannot be accepted). Chapters wishing to pay their full invoice by credit card instead of by a school check should e-mail djones@mdfbla.org to arrange the credit card payment.

Changes to your registration are permitted through 5 p.m. on November 20, 2020. After this time, no changes to your registration are permitted. **Your chapter is financially responsible for all students you have registered in the system by 5 p.m. on November 20, 2020.**
