#### 2. Objective Tests (online) instructions and procedures

The testing window opens on Tuesday, December 1, 2020 and will close at 5:00 p.m. on December 23, 2020.

For RLC team objective test entries, each student will take the objective test at home and it will be individually scored and then averaged for the two (2) or three (3) team members. The normal procedure is that team event objective tests are taken collaboratively, however, this procedure has been modified under the circumstances of students not being in one location to complete the test together/collaboratively.

You will receive an e-mail from the online test administrator, Technological Fluency Institute (TFI), that will allow you to log-in to receive your students' log-in information. See the attached PDF "Advisor Instructions to access student log-in cards for online objective testing (TFI)" that includes instructions on how to obtain log-in information for your students' objective tests.

In brief, chapter advisors: 1) will receive all log-in credentials for each student/event; 2) are responsible for emailing the login information to each student; and 3) are responsible for ensuring that each student completes their test by the deadline.

Please let your students know that when they log in, they will be required to read the Honor Code and type their name in the designated box that indicates they have read and will adhere to the Honor Code. Once they complete this step, they will then start their objective test. A copy of the online objective test Honor Code the students will review and acknowledge online as part of the online testing system is attached for your reference.

The expected date for release of the 2020-21 RLC Winner's List for Objective Test Competitive Events is Wednesday, January 6, 2021. Please note that this release date is subject to change.

The Honor Code for performance events (pre-recorded and live) is attached.
- 2 All video entries must be uploaded to the web link below. If entered as a team, all team members must participate in the virtual event. Only submit one video entry per event/team. Late and/or duplicate entries will not be accepted or judged. Incomplete entries and/or entries that have clerical errors in the web link or in other upload data will not be accepted or judged.
