Also, a special thank you to each of you, our advisors, who supported your students and our state chapter in navigating the virtual process this year. You showed amazing leadership and we are very grateful to each of you.

A couple of reminders as you review the winners lists and begin to think about the state leadership conference:

1. As we mentioned earlier in the school year, the decision on the format of the 2021 State Leadership Conference will depend largely on government directives and school system restrictions as we get closer to the event. **Please stay tuned for an announcement very soon regarding the 2021 State Leadership Conference, including details on registration and competitive events.**
2. **For the 43 objective test events, the top 5 winners for each region are eligible to compete at the 2021 State Leadership Conference.** If 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th place from regionals cannot attend the SLC, 6th place or below are NOT eligible to compete at the SLC.
3. **For the 4 live performance events, the top 3 winners from each region are eligible to compete at the 2021 State Leadership Conference.** If 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place from regionals cannot attend the SLC, the 4th and 5th place at regionals may compete at the SLC. 6th place or below are NOT eligible to compete at the SLC.
