The greatest time of the year, the State Leadership Conference (SLC), is quickly approaching! As you may know, the SLC is being held on March 23th-25th, almost 3 weeks earlier than previous years. Along with this change in the date, the Board of Directors and your State Officer team have prepared many other changes to this year's state conference to make it the best one yet.

Online Testing - For this year's state conference, all testing will be done online at local chapters, similar to the regional competition. Online testing will open on February 27th and will close on March 17th. This change allows for more opportunities for our attendees at the state conference.

Open Events - We have expanded our Open Events program from 2 events to 6 events. Extremely National popular at the Conference, Open Events are competitive events that don't require any pre-qualifications. However, registration is limited and given on first come basis. Therefore, make sure to get to the event location early to get an opportunity to represent your school on the stage!
