Competitive event lists will be verified when events begin and members not fully registered will not be permitted to compete.

Conference Rebate Program-----Every chapter recognized as a Gold Seal Chapter at the 2020 State Leadership Conference is eligible for a \$10 rebate for each individual registered for the conference. To qualify for the rebate, your chapter must meet the requirements of the Gold Seal Chapter Award of Merit event and submit the entry form and all other required information by the deadline. All chapters who are recognized as Gold Seal Chapters at the 2020 SLC will receive a rebate check shortly after the conference. The rebate will be calculated as follows: # of paid attendees x \$10. Attendees include all paid attendees from your chapter (advisors, chaperones, guests, students, etc.).
